



2012 Scholarship List

The Foundation for Amateur Radio, Inc., will be administering the scholarships listed below for the coming academic year, ranging from \$250 to \$5,000 each. All applicants must meet the following minimum requirements:

- Hold a valid amateur radio license,
- Be enrolled, or have been accepted for enrollment, at an accredited university, college or technical school to pursue a **full-time** course of studies.
- Applicants who attend a school located outside of the United States must enclose a brochure describing the school.

In order to be considered for the Chichester, QCWA, 10-10, and OOTC scholarships, applicants must obtain the appropriate signatures on page 6 of the application. These 18 scholarships are worth **\$21,000** in aggregate.
